## QR CODE NECESSARY FOR TRAVELLING INTERNATIONALLY

A Negative RT-PCR test report with QR Code is mandatory for passengers travelling international sectors departing from India. Samples to be taken within 72hrs (48hrs in case of Qatar Airways) prior to the scheduled departure time of the flight. Its aimed to ensure smooth movement and minimum physical

contact.

## EMIRATES EXTENDS TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF FLIGHTS FROM INDIA TILL 30 JUNE



Emirates has extended the temporary suspension of flights from India till June 30th 2021. Additionally passengers who transited through India in the last 14 days are not permitted to board from any other point to the UAE.

However, UAE nationals, holders of UAE Golden Visas and members of diplomatic missions who comply with Covid-19 protocols will be exempt. Passenger carriage from Dubai - India will continue as per available flight schedule.

## DOMESTIC AIR TICKETS GET MORE EXPENSIVE



As International travel is restricted as of now; more and more tourists are opting for domestic travel instead and the demand for inbound travel increased.

The civil aviation ministry decided to raise the lower limit on domestic airfares from **13% - 16% from 1st of June 2021**. The air tickets will get more expensive with an increase in the duration of travel.

If the flight duration is between 40 to 60 minutes, then the lower limit will increase from 2900 to 3300 INR. Likewise, if the flight duration is between 60 to 90 minutes, the lower limit will increase from 3500 to 4000 INR.

The increased airfare has likely caused decline in the number of passengers

## DELHI TO INSTALL AUTOMATED E-GATES FOR IMMIGRATION



Delhi airport to install automated e-gates for Immigration, which will scan passengers without human intervention, thereby making the process safer and smoother. Initially, eight e-gates, four each in departure and arrival immigration areas will be installed. There will be staff present to assist the passengers in the process. The passengers' data will also be recorded with the bureau of immigration for future use.
