




AIR BUBBLE AGREEMENTS ADDED



Although the suspension of regular international passenger flights is extended till October 31, the special flights continue to operate within air bubbles agreement and under the Vande Bharat Mission scheme. Indians will now be able to fly to 16 destinations as new air bubbles have been signed. The list of the countries include Afghanistan, Bahrain, Bhutan, Canada, France, Germany, Iraq, Japan, Kenya, the Maldives, Nigeria, Oman, Qatar, the UAE, the UK, the US. These agreements are the only window that is currently allowing international travel. Under these agreements, airlines of both the countries can carry passengers.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE



Few airlines have revised their baggage allowance in this present situation in order to provide more comfort to the passengers. For example, Indigo has revised their domestic baggage allowance to 15kg (one piece only) per customer effective 1st October'20. The customers who have made their bookings between 21st May and 30th Sep'20 for travel up to 24th Nov'20 will be entitled to 20kg baggage allowance. GoAir has also revised their baggage allowance to 15kg per passenger for tickets booked on or after 14th Oct'20. For more information please click [here](#).

TRAVEL GUIDELINES FOR DUBAI



As you make your travel plans to Dubai, you need to consider the travel guidelines at the first place. Following are the details which you need to be ready with before you pack your bags.

Travel to Dubai requirements

- Fulfil entry visa requirements to visit the UAE.
- Ensure you have medical travel insurance before traveling, in the event you do not have international coverage. Sign a declaration to bear all costs of quarantine and treatment and complete the Health Declaration Form before departure to ensure the passenger has no COVID-19 symptoms.
- Tourists required to register all their details in the COVID-19 DXB app

Procedures from Departure destination

Tourists must take a PCR test up to four days (prior to their date of travel (maximum 96 hours

- Take a PCR test before traveling, or if this hasn't been done, a PCR test is carried out upon arrival at Dubai airports.
- Complete Health Declaration Form before departing.
- Airlines have the right to deny travelers if they display any symptoms of COVID-19.

Procedures upon arrival at Dubai airports

In the event the tourist is not carrying a valid PCR test result, a test is carried out at Dubai airports

- All arrival passengers have their temperature taken with thermal screening devices.
- Tourists who do not carry a valid PCR test result take the test upon arrival
- The PCR test can be repeated for tourists who had tested negative before departing but display COVID-19 symptoms

Moreover, for children or infants travelling from India to Dubai, RT-PCR test is not required. RT-PCR test is mandatory on return to India from Dubai, that means their tests need to be done in Dubai within 96 hrs of boarding Dubai to India flight.
