

In order to contain the spread of COVID - 19 pandemic, international travel of passengers has been prohibited under MHA's orders related to lockdown measures. Hence, many

Indian Nationals who had traveled to different countries before the lockdown due to various reasons such as employment, studies or internships, tourism, business etc., are stranded abroad. Due to their prolonged stay abroad, they are facing distress and are desirous of returning to India urgently. Moreover there are other Indian Nationals who need to visit India in medical emergencies or death of a family member. In order to facilitate the movement of such Indian Nationals, the Ministry Of Home Affairs has issued a Standard Operating Protocol in a circular dated 24th May, 2020.

THE MAGNIFICENT MAJULI



A pollution-free freshwater island in the river Brahmaputra, Majuli is a lush green environment-friendly habitat located 347 Kms from Guwahati and just 20 km from the Jorhat city. Majuli is currently listed as the world's largest river island in the Guinness Book of World Records and it attracts tourists from all over the world. Among one of the most

surreal places in India, Majuli is also a strong contender for a place in UNESCO's World Heritage Sites. The island is a spectacular destination for its flora and fauna, providing shelters to many rare and endangered species including migratory birds that fly in the winter season.

Mostly inhabited by tribals and non-tribals, the island has 144 villages with a population of more than one and half lakh. Majuli has been the cultural capital and the cradle of Assamese civilization for the past 500 years. The uniqueness of the people and their art & culture are untouched by modernism and internationally famous. Significantly, the festivals celebrated here are vibrant and colorful. One of the major festival here is *Raas* - a celebration of Lord Krishna, where people travel miles to get involved in the three day long festival.
