## **Update For Arriving International Transfer Passengers**

According to a circular from Ministry Of Civil Aviation, Govt Of India, and the guidelines stated by Ministry Of Health & Family Welfare, the international arriving passengers having RT - PCR negative report would be exempted from institutional quarantine. Therefore, the international arriving passengers will be allowed for onward air journey as exemption from

institutional quarantine is granted by the State Authorities on the basis of a negative RT-PCR test report. There are separate guidelines for the international passengers who arrive at an entry airport in India without RT-PCR negative certificate and need to take a connecting flight to domestic destinations in India.
